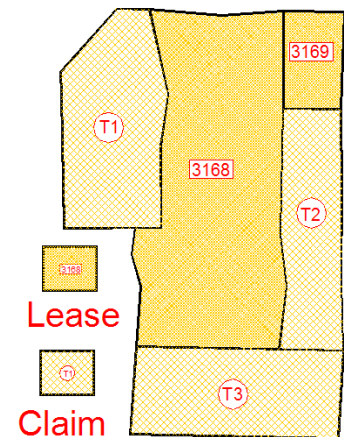
Dear Shareholders,

After successful completion of our second financing, we are glad to inform old and new shareholders about the latest developments of Aurora Resources.

1. Summer Mining Season Highlights

Staking

The Wrigley Zinc Property originally acquired from Teck Cominco Ltd. consists of two leases totaling 1132 hectares. This last June, Aurora staked three further claims surrounding the current leases. This area covers a further 1220 hectares, bringing the total to 2352 hectares.



Drilling

Four percussion drill holes were drilled in May / June. The Bourne Zone orebody was successfully intersected. The overall grade is consistent if not slightly better than the results shown by Cominco in the 1970's.

This drilling demonstrated continuity of ore-grade mineralization to greater depth than was previously indicated. Hole RB07-4 extended the orebody further to the south about 60 meters. The Bourne orebody remains open on strike both north and south and is open to depth.

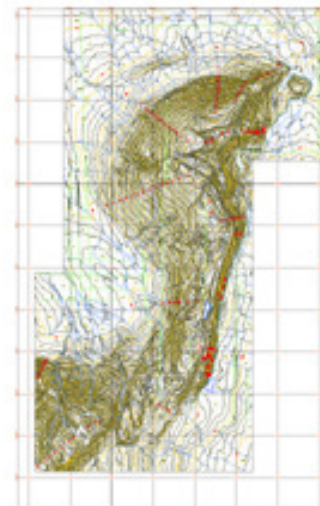
Pehdzeh Ki First Nation Discussions

Aurora Resources Inc. is pleased to announce that it concluded its first round of negotiations culminating in a Memorandum of Understanding between the Company and the local First Nation. This agreement outlines areas of agreement between us, creates a more harmonious relationship and provides a framework for the next round of negotiations which begin this winter.

2. Current Field Activities

Detailed Soil Geochemistry

Following the recommendation of our Q.P., Mike Murrell (P.Geo), work is underway to supplement the intensive geochemical survey done by Cominco Ltd. thirty years ago. Other areas of interest not previously explored will also receive analytical work.



Field Preparations for Airborne Photography

A grid of survey points is being prepared to provide precise control for aerial photography of the property. This gathered information is essential for creating detailed maps. These maps are an important part of preparation for next years field season.

Diamond Drilling

The most important activity is our ongoing drill program. The intention is to drill the Bourne Zone along strike. There will also be fill-in drilling on the 12 Zone and 36 Zone with the view to enhance the geological understanding of those ore bodies.

Drilling is expected to go well into November. Complete analytical results will be known in the new year. We will keep you informed.
